Larry McCubbin began our meeting at 5:35pm. Kathy Blake had a question regarding the computer maintenance invoice showing two months of maintenance for \$320. Korleen explained that the second \$320 happened to be four hours of work done installing new equipment and fixing issues he was given while he was here performing routine maintenance and will correct the claims voucher.

Larry made a motion to accept the March Minutes and April Treasurer's Report as printed, seconded by Jackie Cramer, and the motion passed.

Connie Bartee made the motion to let the Health Department use the meeting room and waive the room fee since it is under a civic category. Larry seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Laney Starbuck will be leading the elementary age Summer Reading Program June 4 to July 9. Korleen is introducing a competition for readers of all ages in addition to the elementary age program. Prizes are already being acquired for the competitions for the number of minutes read.
