APPROVAL OF OCTOBER BOARD MEETING MINUTES- The October 2025 meeting minutes were read and approved.

OLD BUSINESS

- Town Initiatives: Coatesville Downtown Revitalization Christmas Tree Lighting Friday, December 5th 6:00pm; Town BINGO Saturday, December 6th 7:00-8:30pm in the Community Center; Coatesville Downtown Revitalization will be having a House Lighting Contest during December

- Winter Book Sale will be December 2nd through December 20th in the meeting room (\$1/bag)
- Shelly Starbuck's term as a Hendricks Co. Commissioners appointee is expiring on 12/31/2025; she has accepted to return for another four years. The appropriate paperwork has been submitted.
- Town Community Building Rental is increasing to \$150 on January 1, 2026; Discussion to increase Library Meeting Room Rental to also be \$150 so people will seek the town building first. Larry McCubbin made a motion to accept a \$150 rental fee for the Library meeting room rental. Kathy Blake seconded the motion and the motion passed.
- Review Current Bylaws as required by (590 IAC 6-1-4(g))
- Review 8% of Expenditure Data toward Collection Development
8% of \$265,540.00 = \$21,243.22
Current collection development disbursement = \$18,579.11.
(\$14,077.04 Books; \$1,358.08 Periodicals; \$3,143.99 Nonprint Materials)
The library will purchase at least \$3,000 this month to meet the expenditure requirement
- Review funding to explore Employee Recognition possibility. Discussion to allocate \$15,000 for Employee Recognition. Jackie Cramer made a motion to accept \$15,000 as the allocation for Employee Recognition, Robin Cameron seconded the motion and the motion passed.
